

Letter Writing Kits 2011 - Instructions

1. Fill in the blanks with your own information on the form letter- all EXCEPT the line "Dear _____"
2. Make 26 copies (black and white are just fine) of that letter.
3. Starting at the top of the Call-In list on the next page, handwrite each elected official's name in the Dear _____ line, as in Dear "Speaker Oliver," "Senator Vitale," "Assemblyman Conaway," etc.
4. MOST IMPORTANT! The **three leftover** copies are for your local district legislators. Gotta look them up and handwrite those envelopes.
5. Put them in the correct envelope, add your own return address label, and stamp. Up to four sheets of paper can be sent in one envelope with one stamp – so, gather friends & neighbor letters, and send them together to get the most mileage out of your stamp ;)

Wanna follow-up your letters with a call?

Use the Call-in List below to reach members of the NJ Assembly Health Committee, Gov. Christie, and NJ legislative leadership, telling them you want them to vote NO on both A3746/S2659 and A3836/S2625. Refer to our website for talking points.

To find your district:

Click right through from our website, or go to www.njleg.state.nj.us and click on the Districts by Number in the left column. Find your town and the corresponding district number 1-40. If your town is not listed there, ask the folks in the Office of Legislative Services (800-792-8630).

Know that: based on 2010 census data, some legislative districts in New Jersey will be changing. So, heading into Nov. 2011 elections, it is possible that you could be in a new district.
